The advance of science and the amelioration of the physical conditions of life tend rapidly toward a diminution of human mortality. Up to this date slavery had been the foundation of society, and any amelioration in the condition of women had applied only to the patrician class. And how, then and there, the boy had sworn to devote his powers to the amelioration of poverty-stricken lives. Here then we get additional evidence of the amelioration of party spirit, which follows the adoption of a more elastic system of representation. In the history of every measure designed for the amelioration of the people there may be observed four distinct and clearly marked stages. They greatly retard the evolution of a white-labor class, which has become the head-spring of all social amelioration in enlightened communities. I was not the only American appealing to our Embassy for amelioration of my troubles about this time. Yet the remembrance that it was to Petray, of all people, that he owed this amelioration of his misery, stung him as with a lash. The Revolution brought no immediate betterment to his conditions; such slight amelioration as came later was the result of years of agitation. We find ourselves hedged in at every effort we make as mothers for the amelioration of society, as philanthropists, as Christians. All English insurgent parties have shown similar animosity against amelioration of evil, lest it diverted attention from absolute redress. Of this class of services, that which reflects on him the most honor, is his amelioration of the Criminal Law. In the early days most of the charitable work in this country was directed to the amelioration of the condition of some particular group of unfortunates. It has been demonstrated that there is a psychic power inherent in man which can be employed for the amelioration of his own physical condition, as well as that of his fellows. It was to that, indeed, that people turned by habit when minded to invest in the amelioration of the East End. He saw himself the necessity of something being done towards the amelioration of the condition of the two unhappy individuals; but he acknowledged the difficulty of effecting it.
